

Kalzip NatureRoof Plant Species

1. **Sedum ellacombianum:** vigorous grower that creates mounds of shiny, bright, green leaves. Masses of bright, yellow flowers, in late summer. Height approx. 10cm+, full sun to partial shade. Dormant during winter.
2. **Sedum floriferum:** forms a low spreading clump of spoon shaped leaves, clusters of star shaped bright yellow flowers, borne in the leaf axils in late summer. Height 10cm, full sun to partial shade, semi-evergreen.
3. **Sedum montanum:** Needle-like blue green leaves. Yellow flowers appear in mid-summer. montanum is hardy & tolerates summer heat. Height 10cm+. Prefers full sun but tolerates partial shade, semi-evergreen.
4. **Sedum oreganum:** forms close-packed clusters of green leaves turning bronze-red in high summer. Flowers are clusters of small bright yellow stars in June to August. Height 10 cm, prefers full sun, evergreen.
5. **Sedum pulchellum:** pale green to lime green, Stem are topped by tiny pink flowers. Height 10-15 cm, prefers full sun but tolerates partial shade, evergreen.
6. **Sedum Rupestre 'Angelina':** Lime green leaves turn to bright yellow in summer, to orange and reds in autumn. Height 10cm+, full sun to partial shade, evergreen.
7. **Sedum spurium:** sprawling, semi-evergreen, with dark bronze-red leaves that become greener throughout the summer, flowers of deep rose-pink star shaped flowers in later summer. Height 10cm+, prefers full sun.
8. **Sedum stenopetalum:** Mat or cushion forming evergreen perennial flowers in mid summer, bright green leaves sometime flushed with oranges, clusters of lemon yellow star shaped flowers, does not tolerate shade.
9. **Saxifraga granulata:** Mat forming evergreen perennial with small lobed leaves and white to pink or yellow flowers in small clusters in late spring or early summer. Height (potentially) 35cm, tolerates shade, evergreen.

10. **Sedum hispanicum:** Compact mat forming evergreen pale blue green leaves, turning reddish in winter, clusters of salmon pale pink flowers in the summer. Prefers full sun, height 10cm, evergreen

11. **Sedum album (White stonecrop):** Appearance changes with the seasons: wet periods-green and lush, dry periods-can be red, bronze or brown. Leaf size can also change depending on season and location. Blunt, scattered leaves. Small pink-white flowers between Jun-Aug. Height approx. 10-15cm, full sun, evergreen.

12. **Sedum spurium Coccineum:** Comes in many forms. Large flat, broad leaves, creeping and evergreen. Coccineum has leaves that tinge red and redder flowers, flowers Jun-Aug. 13. **Sedum stoloniferum:** Loose mat forming and creeping, red stems bare five petalled pink flowers Height approx. 5-10cm, will tolerate moist shade, evergreen.

14. **Sedum hybridum 'Czar's Gold':** Low dense mat forming habit with narrow scalloped dark green leaves which turns orange to red in Autumn. Flowers golden yellow in July to Aug. Height 10—15cm, full sun to partial shade, evergreen

15. **Sedum sexangulare:** Easily recognised by its six spirals of parallel-sided, oblong leaves, which are clearly visible when looking down on it. Leaves green turning copper coloured and more compact in full sun, yellow flowers, tolerates partial shade, forms low carpet. Height 8-10cm.

16. **Sedum spurium 'Summer Glory':** Forms a low carpet, with small rounded leaves, clusters of bright deep pink star shaped flowers in early to mid-summer Height 10-15cm, full sun, shade tolerant.

17. **Sedum reflexum, aka rupestre:** Probably introduced to Britain in middle ages. Sturdy, upright plant with tall, bright yellow flowers. When in bud the tips are reflexed or turned over. The species is variable but the form/shape is distinct. Height 10cm, full sun, evergreen.

18. **Sedum kamtschaticum:** Produced mounds of medium to dark green broad leaves, very branched, low growing. Flowers, star shaped yellow May-July. Height 10cm, prefers full sun but will tolerate partial shade, semi-evergreen.
